Logging in to NetLibrary Audiobooks for the First Time

The first thing you need to do is create your account.

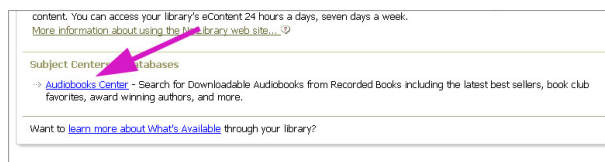
1. Visit any Anderson County Library System Location
2. Access any internet Machine at that location
3. Start at our homepage: www.andersonlibrary.org
4. Go to the NetLibrary Audiobook Link on the main page.
5. Click on the link to access NetLibrary audiobooks. (You should see a starburst in the upper right hand corner)
6. Click on the “Create a Free Account” link in the upper right hand corner.
7. Enter your information
8. Click on Submit.



This creates the account that you can use to check out the audiobooks. You must have an account. If you do not have an account you can not download the audiobooks. Once you have an account you can go directly to NetLibrary at www.netlibrary.com/recordedbooks

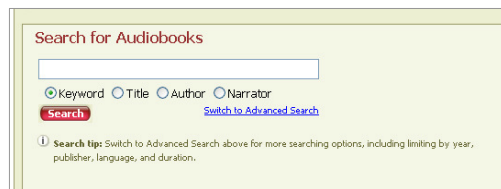
Searching for an Audiobook

The first thing you want to do when searching for a book is to limit it to just the audiobooks. You do this by clicking on the “Audiobook Center” Link below the search window.



Basic Search lets you quickly perform a search by entering terms and selecting a single search field. You may choose to search for your terms in the Keyword, Title, Author, or Narrator fields.

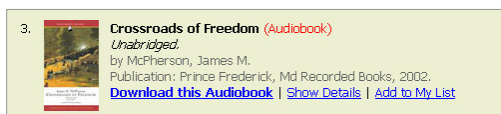
1. Enter search term in the Basic Search field.
2. Select Keyword, Title, Author, or Narrator.
3. Click search.



Checking out an Audiobook

The default checkout period for a Downloadable Audiobook is three weeks. You may check out a maximum of six audiobook titles at one time.

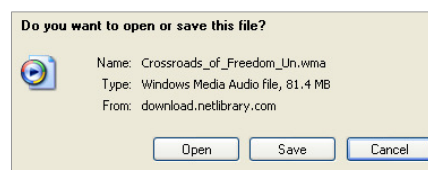
1. From Search Results, click on the Download this Audiobook link to save the audiobook file.



2. Select a download option: use CD quality for transferring to the MP3 player. To estimate your download time use the Cable Modem approximate time.



3. Click Save.
4. Once you have it downloaded turn this page over for instructions to transfer it to your MP3 Player.

Transferring to Your MP3 Player with Windows Media Player 10

If you do not have Windows Media Player 10 you can download it at www.microsoft.com

1. Plug your MP3 Player into the USB port on the computer.

2. Locate the File you just downloaded.

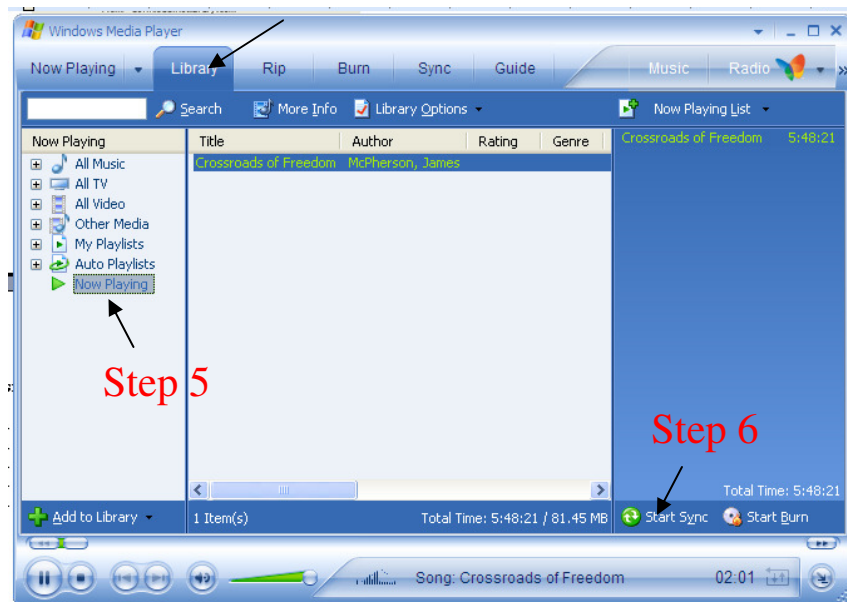

3. Double click on your audiobook.
(This will open Windows Media Player and start playing your Audiobook.)

4. Click on the Library tab.

5. Click on “Now Playing.”

6. Click on “Start Sync” in the lower right hand corner of the  window to load the file to your MP3 Player.



7. When it says it is done synchronizing to the device, click on the “Safely Remove Hardware” icon by the Clock in the lower right hand corner. 

8. Click on the “Safely Remove USB Mass Storage Device” popup.



9. Once your MP3 player is able to be safely disconnected from the computer the following popup will appear. You can then unplug your MP3 player.
