It's been a very busy and exciting nine months since the last BookMarks was published. We apologize for not communicating with you in all that time, but there were good reasons. A new, larger branch library was built in Belton and the Friends published and promoted Rich Otter's book, *Anderson County: 20th Century Memories and Reflections*. Our new Mobile Library took to the roads in January.

At the Main Library, new software was installed to better control how patrons' documents were printed from the public computers. Also, patrons may now register for Internet computers on their own instead of working exclusively through the Reference Desk staff. The word processing computers have been moved to a more user-friendly area near the Periodicals Desk. These computers also are newer models.

The library is now a valuable source of information for anyone interested in establishing a new business in the area. InFoMentum, a Geographic Information Service, assists in evaluating geographic areas of the county for the purpose of locating businesses in the right place for maximum consumer traffic. Call Reference librarians Gael Johnson or Alex Currin for help in custom-designing a report for your use.

And, in our continuing efforts to provide our services in the most efficient manner possible, we've entered into a study of library staffing patterns with the Appalachian Council of Governments. We're all being questioned, watched, and evaluated to make sure we're doing the best job possible for you. And now we're looking ahead to replace the branch libraries in Pendleton and Powdersville with newer, much larger facilities.

As we continue to strive to provide better, expanded services for each person in the county, we wish to thank the members of the Anderson County Council, the County Administrator and his staff, the members of the Board of Trustees of the library, and the Board of Directors of the Friends of the Library for all the hard work they've performed in a cooperative spirit in order to improve library services in Anderson County.
