FAQ & Rules

What is the Love Your Library Bookmark Contest?: Patrons of the Anderson County Library System are invited to enter the Love Your Library Bookmark Contest! Winners will be chosen in the following categories: Birth-Preschool (ages 0-5), Children (ages 6-12), Teens (ages 13-17), Adults (ages 18+) and Library Director's Choice. Winners will have their designs professionally printed on our library bookmarks and will be handed out at all library locations while supplies last.

What can be entered? Any style of artwork (physical or digital) is accepted, as long as it is your own work and is submitted with a contest form. Due to the nature of a bookmark, only 2D art will be allowed for this contest and must fit on a 2"x8.5" bookmark (template attached.) Entries must contain no graphic or adult content, obscene language, or use Al. Any entry that violates these rules will be disqualified and not displayed. I entry per contestant.

When to enter: Drop off your artwork and entry form at any Anderson County Library location, including the Bookmobile, during regular library hours February 1-29, or email your artwork and entry form to communityservices@andersonlibrary.org. Digital artwork must be submitted in PNG, JPG, or PDF format in CMYK, with a DPI of 300 or more.

What will happen to my artwork? Artwork submitted will be displayed at your local branch or the Main Library during the month of March. Any artwork may be displayed on the Anderson County Library's website, www.andersonlibrary.org, or on any of the library's social media platforms for the duration of the contest and any length of time after.

Can I get my artwork back after the contest? Yes! You may pick up your artwork during the first week of April. All artwork must be picked up by Friday, April 5.
